

OUR INVITATION TO YOU 10th Biennial Queensland Heritage Rally "Rare Trade Workshops"

The Callide Dawson Machinery Preservation Club Inc. is calling on all aspiring blacksmiths, coopers and leatherworkers to take part in a series of "Rare Trade" workshops to be held at the 10th Biennial Queensland Heritage Rally on the 19th, 20th & 21st July, 2024.

This year we have arranged for the following workshops:

BLACKSMITHING WORKSHOPS

Martin Geddes from Geddes Blacksmithing Queensland is returning this year to host a series of three workshops – "ABC of Tong Making. Encompassing many of the techniques and skill sets all metalworking enthusiasts need, these workshops will provide participants with the skills and knowledge to create integral tools for blacksmithing and will provide you with the opportunity to build the basis of your own tong collection.

Martin will work through each step of the process with participants and a full understanding of tong-making will be explained along with discussions pertaining to solid fuel fire maintenance.

• Workshop participants must wear steel cap boots, cotton drill workwear (no short pants or short sleeve shirts) and a cap/hat for your head. No gloves are required.

- Please bring a water bottle. You will be encouraged to drink plenty of water during the workshops.
- As blacksmithing is a physical activity the participants should be mindful of their ability to hold and use a hammer, hold their work piece and are able to freely move about and active working environment.

COOPERING WORKSHOPS

Artisan, David Harriman from Colonial Woodcrafts will be introducing the art of coopering through full day bucket making workshops. After the workshop you will not only take home your bucket, but also the knowledge of how to design and construct you own wooden vessels.

David have previously held these workshops at the Maleny Wood Expo, Cobb & Co Museum Toowoomba and at Highfields Pioneer Village.

LEATHERWORKING WORKSHOPS

Terri & Nathan Lee from TJ's Leathercraft will be hosting three belt making workshops during the rally. This is a full belt making experience. You will learn about the different types of hide and how to select leather, cutting, punching, embossing and dyeing. You will also be able to choose the colour of your belt along with the hardware prior to bevelling and burnishing the edges to create a beautiful finish on your leather and stitching/setting the hardware.

Whatever, you choose, you will be taking home a premium quality belt created by you that will last for many years to come.
